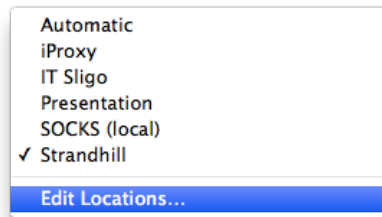


Connecting a Mac OS X Computer to IT Sligo's "Wifi_open" network

Create a location called IT Sligo:

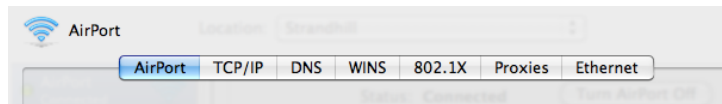
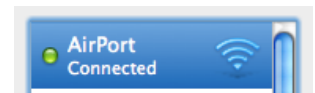
1. Open System Preferences -> Network -> Choose "Edit Locations" from the drop-down menu at the top of the window.



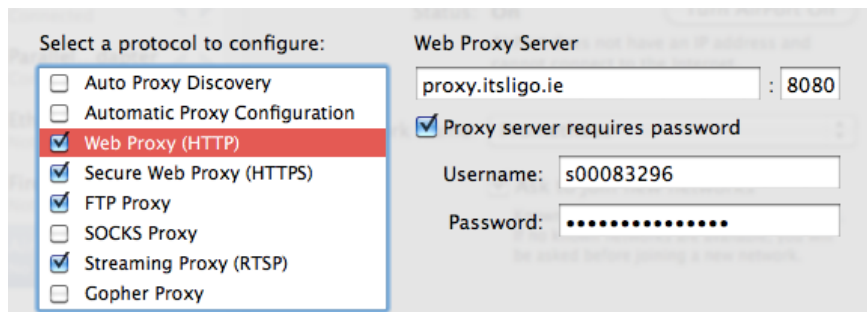
2. Click the small "+" symbol.
3. Enter the name of "IT Sligo"
4. Close the drop-down menu.

Configure your computer to use the college proxy:

1. Click on the "Airport" network interface.
2. Click on Advanced. This should be in the bottom right corner.
3. Now click on the tab called Proxies



4. Now configure your settings so that they all look like the diagram below:

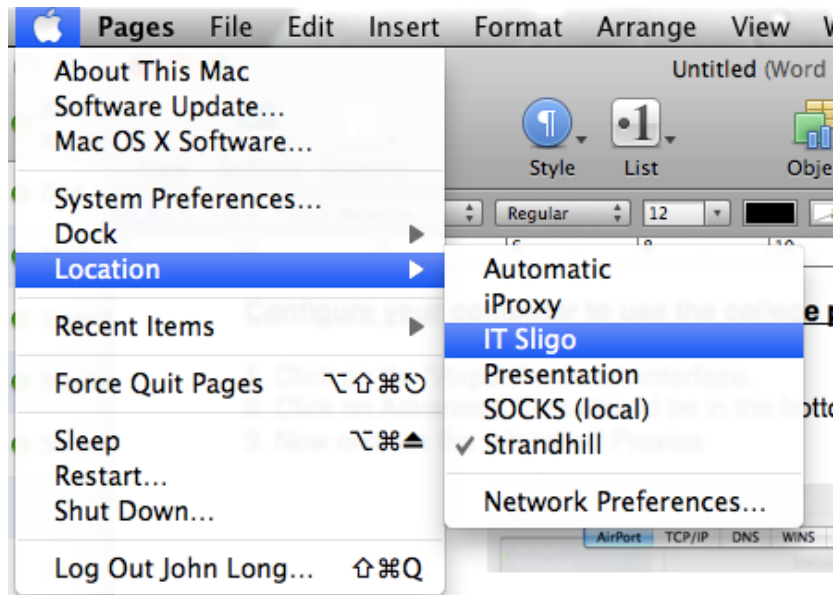


5. Where I have my student number entered, replace that with your own and enter your college password into the "Password" field.
6. Click "OK"
7. Click "Apply"
8. Now join the WiFi network called "Wifi_open"
9. Done!

Now you should be on the college WiFi!

Please note that due to restrictions in place on the wireless you cannot access the H or S drives or check email using mail clients like Outlook or Thunderbird.

In future when in the college simply select the correct location from the Apple menu and these settings will be automatically applied. When returning home, set the location back to Automatic or whatever your previous setting was!
